Safety Checklist: Installing UteDividers onto a Ute on a Worksite

Pre-Installation Checks

	Conduct Job Safety Analysis (JSA) or SWMS.
	Ensure ute is parked on level ground, handbrake engaged, wheels chocked.
	Turn off engine and remove keys.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

	Safety gloves.
	Eye protection.
	Steel-capped boots.
	Hearing protection if using power tools.

Tool & Equipment Safety

	Inspect tools for damage before use.
	Use correct drill bits and fasteners.
	Ensure RCD protection for power tools.

Manual Handling

	Assess weight and awkwardness of components. Is < 6kg
	Maintain proper posture and avoid twisting.
	Use two-person lift or mechanical aid for heavy components.

Worksite Hazards

	Clear area of trip hazards.
	Barricade or mark work zone.
	Be aware of moving plant and vehicles.

Installation Safety

	Avoid drilling near fuel lines or electrical wiring.
	Secure brackets properly.
	Check hand nuts and hand bolts are tight.

Post-Installation

	Inspect installation for stability.
	Remove tools and debris.
	Update vehicle modification records if required.
